

Project Check Lists

Please keep the items listed under each product in mind as you work on your project. They will all be considered by the judges to determine your score.

Research Project

Have you.....

- given your paper a title?
- used at least three sources (books, magazines, encyclopedia)? Remember, the Internet will not be counted as one of the three sources.
- included a list of sources (bibliography) at the end of your paper? This includes titles of sources used, publisher, copyright, and pages used.
- changed the information you found in the sources into your own words?
- provided evidence of research? This could be either index cards or sheets of paper. Remember that research is an important part of writing a paper.
- written the title of the source and pages used at the top of each index card or piece of paper?
- checked for mistakes in spelling, capitalization, punctuation and usage?
- checked to make sure your report sticks to the topic?
- checked to make sure your sentences and paragraphs fit together well?
(Remember that during the week before the Social Studies Fair you will be asked some questions about your project.)

Model Project

Have you....

- given your project a title?
- provided written information about your model? Remember that you must include a list of sources (bibliography) with your written material. Sources include books, magazines, or an encyclopedia. At least one source is needed. The Internet may be used but does not count as one of the sources.
- made sure the model is the most important part of the project?
- provided evidence of research? This could be either index cards or sheets of paper.
- made the model look as much as the real object as possible?
- made sure the model is of a man-made structure?
- included a List of Materials page? (Mr. Stubalt has extras.)
- included a List of Steps page? (Mr. Stubalt has extras.)
- included at least two pictures of the model?
(Remember that during the week before the Social Studies Fair you will be asked some questions about your project.)

Map Project

Have you....

- given your project a title?
- included a compass rose?
- explained what the symbols on your map mean?
- included a List of Materials page? (Mr. Stubalt has extras.)
- included a List of Steps page? (Mr. Stubalt has extras.)
- included a picture of the continent, country, or state you chose?
- A list of sources must be included. The titles of sources used, publisher, copyright, and pages used must be present. Only one source – book, magazine, encyclopedia – is needed. The Internet will not be considered as a source.
(Remember that during the week before the Social Studies Fair you will be asked some questions about your project.)
