Dear Parents,

It is time for you to register your child for a second semester elective course. The same three courses will offered again this year. Mr. Fillner will teach the Economics class; Mr. Hochmuth will teach Explorations; Mr. Washburn will teach the Lab Skills class.

The registration will be done online. You will be able to choose from the three courses indicating your first, second, and third choices. Every effort will be made to ensure that the students are enrolled in their favorite class; however, the classes will be limited to size and resources. Priority is given to the eighth grade students – especially those who did not receive their first choice last year. After that, registration is done on a first come – first served basis. Students may not take the same elective twice.

Once you navigate to the registration address, please fill out the form. You will receive an automated email from Mr. Washburn confirming your registration. We ask that you please register by the end of December.

Once all the registrations are received, we will work to finalize the course enrollments and publish that information to the parents and students. Elective classes will begin on Monday, January 23, and will be held every Monday and Wednesday morning.
